"Aviation legends" are remarkable people who have achieved extraordinary feats in aviation:

Margrit Waltz, the queen of ferry flights, completed her 960th ferry flight across the Atlantic in a TBM 960, which she describes as the ultimate model, having flown from serial number 5.

The flight took 15 hours and 38 minutes, from Daher's TBM production plant in Tarbes, France, to Daher Aerospace's US base of operations in Pompano Beach, Florida, with stopovers in Wick, UK, Keflavik, Iceland, and Goose Bay, Canada.
